**Where:** Chrauk Tiek Village, Aural District, Trapeang Chor Commune, Kampong Speu Province, Kingdom of Cambodia. A small, rural village in the southern Cardamom Mountains.

**Built By:** American Assistance for Cambodia, “Put A Roof Over Their Heads Fund”

**Cost of building:** \$15,700 donation was made by George and Kari Grady Grossman to AAfC in January 2001 which was matched by the World Bank. Total cost was \$30,000 for a five room cement block building.
